

Rules and Instructions

From May 1 to May 31

- Explore Farmington by riding your bicycle to school, on errands, for exercise, or for a family adventure.
- Pay attention to all traffic laws and safety requirements!
- Take your passport to the businesses listed inside and hand it to a cashier to get that business's unique stamp.
- Continue collecting stamps from as many of the businesses listed as you can!

To Get Your Free T-Shirt (one t-shirt per passport):

- Bring your passport with you as you attend, ride, or march in either of the Farmington Memorial Day parades on **May 26, 2014**. Patriotically-decorated bicycles are encouraged, but please keep in mind that the day is a patriotic remembrance for those who have died in our nation's service.
- Line up 8am at intersection of New Britain Ave. & Rt. 177, Unionville.
- Line up 10am at intersection of Garden St. & Farmington Ave., Farmington.

- **OR**, bring your passport to the Bicycle Friendly Farmington public meeting at 7pm on **June 5, 2014** at Town Hall.
- **OR**, drop your passport off at the Farmington Public Library (Main Branch) **before May 31**.
